Death on the Reik - This book has a few references to Morrslieb and its chaotic behavior that blights the land beneath, see for example pages 2-3 under "Dagmar vong Wittgenstein" and pages 42 to 44.

Dying of the Light deals with strange astrological events, such as an eclipse (see pages 12 and 13 for example, or pages 86 and 87).

The Enemy Within Campaign - Detail on the two moons can be found on the "Player Information" handout titled "Your Homeland - The Empire" under "Notes on the Calendar" including the cycles of the moons and the legend of Morrslieb. Specific dates in the context of the months can be found on the Calendar on the reverse side of the handout and specific references to these two dates under the heading "Months and Festivals".

Geheimnisnacht in William King's Trollsayer, printed in an earlier Warhammer anthology as well covers the adventures of a psychotic dwarf and his human pet during this night.

Realms of Chaos: Lost and the Damned touches upon Beastmen society and The Brayherd, an event that easily could occur on any of these two sacred nights (see page 131).

Shadows Over Bogenhafen - This book provides details on some of the more peculiar behaviors of the moon when the forces of chaos become more powerful and influential. Its behavior during this time can be duplicated during these evil nights. See also "The Grinning Moon" page 35

White Dwarf 106 - This issue contains a solo WFRP adventure called "*Night of Mystery*" which takes place on Geheimnisnacht and covers the strange happenings at a small village called Grimminghan.
